If you are taking any medicines on this list, you need to call 211 or your doctor right away.

- Digoxin a heart medicine
- Probenecid for gout
- Diabetes medicines, insulin or pills
- Rifampin for tuberculosis
- Coumadin or warfarin blood thinner
- Accutane for acne
- Theophylline a breathing medicine
- Dilantin, barbiturates, or carbamazepine seizure medicines
- Lithium for mental health
- Cyclosporine for immune system problems
- Methotrexate for arthritis, cancer, psoriasis or lupus
- Requip for Parkinson's disease

Taking the emergency antibiotics with any of these medicines may cause serious, even life threatening, side effects.

Your doctor may want to change the medicine or the amount you take, or the doctor may want you to have more tests.
